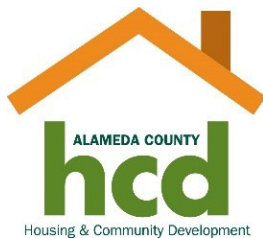


What is Alameda County Housing Secure?

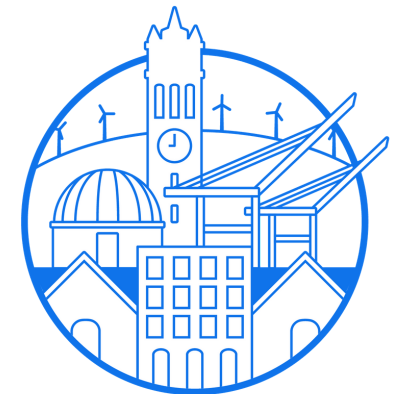

Services

Legal assistance for tenants facing:

- Eviction
- Notices of termination of tenancy
- Needed repairs and bad conditions
- Rent increases
- Other landlord-tenant disputes

Legal assistance for homeowners facing:

- Foreclosures
- Problems with property taxes
- Homeowner Association (HOA) assessments
- PACE loans
- Deed theft
- Blight citations

Financial assistance:

- One-time grants to help tenants and homeowners stay in their homes
- Offered in connection with legal services provided through Alameda County Housing Secure

Eligibility

Free legal services:

Tenants and homeowners who:

- Live in Alameda County
- Are low-income (for a family of 4, low-income is a household annual income at or below \$89,600). Call to determine eligibility
- Are at risk of losing their homes

Emergency financial assistance:

Tenants and homeowners who:

- Live in Alameda County
- Meet income guidelines. Tenants must be very low-income (below \$58,000 for a family of 4) and homeowners must be low-income (below \$89,600 for a family of 4). Call to determine eligibility.
- Are at imminent risk of losing their home
- Have experienced an event that made them temporarily unable to pay their housing costs
- Are receiving legal services from a provider listed in this brochure
